1. Submit your mini-term request on the Course Request Form according to the timetable for Spring 2009 Semester.
2. Students may enroll in one mini-term course each mini-term. Students may enroll in two mini-term courses by enrolling in one each mini-term.
3. A 1L student taking Intro Plus may not enroll in a mini-term course unless the Plus instructor and Associate Dean permit such enrollment. Also a 1L student taking Intro Plus cannot enroll in any Advanced Torts class.
4. A student's mini-term request will be considered for approval together with the student's regular course request for purposes of the "credit hours per semester rule" and the residency rules.
5. Grades earned by 1Ls in mini-courses will not count in GPAs until the second year.
